

- All contestants must have completed (or be currently enrolled for) not less than three (3) course units with Northern Arizona University between June 1, 2022, and March 31, 2024.
- 2. The blind judging is done by a panel of three faculty members in the School of Communication.
- 3. A contestant may submit no more than two (2) entries to the contest.
- 4. Each entry must be submitted via email as follows:
 - In PDF (be sure to save the entry form onto your computer).
 - A completed entry form is required for each submission.
 - <u>Each entry must have a title page</u> stating the title of the submission and the approximate number of words of the submission.
 - **The name of the author shall NOT appear** on the title page or elsewhere in the submission.
 - Pages must be numbered in upper right corner.
 - The title of the submission must appear in the upper right corner of each page. The title may be abbreviated. (Example) "George Meets the Flying Pig" could be "George... 3"
 - Entries must be typed and double spaced on white paper.
 - Use a regular type face (such as Times New Roman 12 or Arial 12, preferred).
 - 1" margins on 8.5" x 11" paper.
 - Your submission will include two pdf attachments: the completed entry form and your manuscript.

6. Entries will be judged as follows:

Subjectively – based on their humor (how funny are they?) and their originality. Objectively – Appropriate use of basic English composition skills and following directions. NOTE: Egregious errors in spelling, syntax, etc., OR failure to follow Contest Rules and Requirements may cause entries to be disqualified or to lose substantial points.
