WEAPONS ON CAMPUS

POLICY SUMMA

Request must be approved in advance, to temporarily use, possess, display, or store a Weapon or a simulated Weapon on University property or at University activities or events in furtherance of legitimate University business. Requests may be submitted to the NAU Chief of Police and are considered on a case-by-case basis by the NAU Chief of Police.

REASON FOR THIS POLICY

Regulating Weapons helps maintain the

other authorized activities, the transport or storage of any Weapon in a University owned, leased, or rented motor vehicle is also prohibited.

B. Permanent Exceptions

The prohibition outlined in Paragraph A does not apply to the following:

01. Personal Safety Devices that are designed for the protection of the individual (e.g., pepper spray, stun batons, etc.)

received. If the Chief or designee approves the request, the approval may include conditions or restrictions deemed necessary to protect public safety or to ensure compliance with applicable University policy.

H. Enforcement

In addition to sanctions that may be imposed under applicable law, violations of this policy by students are subject to disciplinary action under the Student Code of Conduct up to and including suspension and expulsion. Violations by employees are subject to disciplinary action under applicable Arizona Board of Regents and NAU employee conduct
