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**Affiliation Agreements are used to establish affiliate relationships between Northern Arizona University and other institutions to allow the University's students to participate in academic credit-bearing educational experiences, such as supervised clinical or other fieldwork experiences or internship programs, at the host affiliate's location. Affiliation Agreements define the applicable terms and conditions and the respective Academic Responsibilities of each party.**

**The academic unit Program Coordinator is responsible for initiating, as appropriate, either a standard or nonstandard Affiliation Agreement when seeking to establish a relationship with a third party educational affiliate. Types of agreements:**

- 1. CHS Standard agreement - Covers Clinical Mental Health Counseling, Clinical Psychology, PsyD, Combined School Psychology and Counseling PhD**
- 2. Nonstandard agreement - Some affiliates request changes to the language in the "standard" agreement, which necessitates a "nonstandard" agreement. A nonstandard agreement involves negotiations between NAU and the affiliate and can take an extended amount of time to finalize.**
